## Program administration

- The Jan Cathcart Scholarship will commence from semester 1, 2019. Full year payments of \$10,000 will be paid to the student's nominated university during enrolment each year.
- Student liaison, including course payments will be facilitated by SunRice.
- Once enrolled, students will be required to remain enrolled in a relevant undergraduate degree, and achieve a satisfactory standard of academic progress.
- Students must maintain an acceptable course weighted average and fail no more than one unit per semester. Academic monitoring of scholarship recipients will occur each semester.
- A student who withdraws from their units or course of study or is terminated from studies will become ineligible for continuation of the scholarship and will be required to repay to the university any stipend awarded for that study period.
- The Jan Cathcart Scholarship has been awarded for the selected undergraduate degree and university and is not transferable into any other course or university without permission from the Selection Committee.
